Champagne & Sparkling Wines

Moët & Chandon “Imperial”, France.....	\$85.00
<i>Rich and creamy, this seems easy, yet has plenty of honey, candied fruit and apple notes, filling out its medium-bodied frame. It is soft, with enough acidity to keep it focused.</i>	
Veuve Clicquot “Yellow Label” Brut, France.....	\$92.00
<i>Aromas of lemon, currant, clove and mint; slightly rustic, then fresh and frothy, with a strong mousse. Distinctly floral suggestion of rose petal to go with the berry flavors, it boasts plenty of extract, and a generous, firm finish.</i>	
Santa Margherita Prosecco	\$42.00
<i>Sparkling wine with a clean nose, pleasantly fruity, with whiffs of Rennet apples and peach blossoms. Delicate, balanced taste.</i>	
Roederer Estate Brut, California	\$48.00
<i>Crisp and elegant with complex pear, spice and hazelnut flavors. It is fresh and lightly fruity with great finesse and depth of character.</i>	

White Wines

- Chardonnay, Greg Norman Estates, Santa Barbara, California**..... \$38
This wine begins with bright aromas of pineapple and lemon zest. Forward tropical fruit flavors greet the palate and are highlighted by notes of vanilla and hints of spice. The mouth-feel is smooth and luscious and the wine finishes clean and refreshing.
- Chardonnay, Ferrari-Carano, California** \$48
This wine features floral and fruit aromas of pear, Fuji apple, citrus and honey graham cracker with a hint of rich caramel and toasted coconut marshmallow. Generous on the palate, creamy vanilla undertones balance layers of toast and spice on the finish, while the tropical flavors linger to the end.
- Chardonnay, Solaire by Robert Mondavi**..... \$34
This Chardonnay displays aromas and flavors of citrus, pear, mango and freshly cut pineapple, supported by spicy and smoky nuances from 100% French oak.
- Chardonnay, Kendall-Jackson, Santa Barbara County**..... \$56
Tropical flavors such as mango and pineapple dance with aromas of peach, apple and pear. Richly layered and balanced throughout. Lightly buttered toast headlines the indulgent, lingering finish.
- Pouilly-Fuissé, Laboure-Roi, France**..... \$45
Pale buttery gold in color, floral and fruity, hints of honey and hazelnuts on the nose. Rich but dry, rounded white fruit flavors and ripe finish
- Pinot Grigio, Santi Sortesele, Italy** \$38
This is a bright, straw yellow color with an unusual elegance. The bouquet is concentrated with exotic fruits, lemon and lime. It is rich in mouth feel with a long, lingering aftertaste.
- Pinot Grigio, Santa Margherita, Italy** \$52
This dry white wine is pale straw-yellow in color. The clean, intense aroma and dry flavor with pleasant golden apple aftertaste make this a wine of great character and versatility.
- Pinot Grigio, La Tunella** \$38
The bouquet is full of rich tropical fruits and acacia flowers. Robust, full-bodied to the palate and moderately acidic, this wine combines well with the pleasant hint of vanilla.
- Gavi di Gavi, Italy** \$48
100% Cortese grapes, delicate mineral flavors with a dry and clean finish. A phenomenal summer white.
- Sauvignon Blanc, Charles Krug, Napa Valley, California**..... \$35
This wine's inviting and complex bouquet blends notes of peach, green apple, melon, banana, guava and grapefruit. Its silky texture, crisp acidity and long finish make it a delicious wine.
- Sauvignon Blanc, Oyster Bay, Marlborough, New Zealand**..... \$32
It has that trademark "gooseberry" flavor of Sauvignon Blancs from Marlborough. Prominent grapefruit and green apricot flavors and acids which are crisp enough to make your mouth water.

Red Wines

- Cabernet Sauvignon, Robert Mondavi, “Napa”, California \$68**
This Cabernet Sauvignon has deep, expressive aromas and flavors of berry and black currant with nuances of mocha, violets and spice. The fruit envelops an elegant structure with firm, velvety tannins and excellent length.
- Cabernet Sauvignon, Chateau Ste Michelle, Washington \$38**
Highlights concentrated Washington red fruit in an accessible style. It offers expressive blackberry and black fruit characteristics and is a touch floral with plenty of complexity and structure.
- Chianti Riserva, Da’ Vinci, Italy \$42**
The flavor reflects the spicy undertones and fruit of the bouquet, supported by balanced tannins. This Riserva exhibits concentrated black fruit, plums, and ripe cherry fruit with spicy undertones and is balanced by fine, soft tannins and a full mineral finish.
- Merlot, Chateau Ste. Michelle, Washington..... \$38**
The wine shows complex aromas of black cherries, red licorice and a touch of cedar. The mid-palate emphasizes sweet fruit, with a lingering cherry finish. It has the typical full structure of a Washington state Merlot.
- Merlot, Robert Mondavi “Private Selection”, Central Coast, California \$32**
Bright aromas and flavors of smooth cherry, plum and strawberry with hints of cedar, black olive and spice—supported by a supple texture with fine-grained tannins and bright acidity.
- Merlot, Simi Winery, Sonoma County, California \$56**
Bright cherry, plum and blackberry aromas, accented with baking spices, cocoa and roses. Upfront red berry fruit, medium-bodied with elegance and balance.
- Médoc, Château Larose, France \$48**
Intense, deep, lively color, ripe tannins, aromas of wild red fruits; powerful with remarkable full-bodied complexity.
- Merlot, Casa Lapostolle, Cuvée Alexandre, Rapel Valley, Chile..... \$46**
The nose features polished oak and bright berry aromas; the palate offers a perfect feel and impressive plum, berry, chocolate and vanilla flavors; properly tannic and balanced.
- Merlot, Carmen, Rapel Valley, Chile \$31**
Bright and deep strawberry red color with intense aromas of caramel, cherries and ripe strawberries. On the palate appears red fruits and coffee with soft tannins and lingering finish.

Red Wines

- Pinot Noir, La Crema, Sonoma Coast, California** \$64
Aromas of ripe cherry, cocoa, anise and rich baking spices. Plush flavors of cherry, plum and pomegranate meld with hints of delicate tea leaf. Structured, balanced acidity and elegant, firm tannins round out the mouth.
- Pinot Noir, Buena Vista, Carneros, California**..... \$48
Aromas of bright Bing cherry, fresh ground nutmeg and earthy, wild mushroom. The palate explores hints of toastiness and exhibits flavors of deep blackberry and cherry with undertones of dark chocolate and clove spice. This is a wine of depth that leads to a long finish, complemented by soft tannins and lingering berry fruit.
- Châteauneuf-du-Pâpe, Lazaret, Burgundy, France** \$72
Has a full, deep color with the bouquet of spice and old leather, with flavor and balance of tannin, length and ripe fruit.
- Chianti, Peppoli, Antinori, Tuscany, Italy**..... \$44
90% Sangiovese and 10% Merlot and Syrah grapes. Rich in aromas of mature fruits and hints of vanilla. A well-balanced, clean and elegant wine.
- Shiraz, Jacob's Creek Reserve, Barossa Valley, Australia** \$42
Light and appealing for a sense of delicacy to go along with the focused cherry and plum flavors, lingering against refined tannins.
- Cabernet Sauvignon, Greg Norman Estates, North Coast, California**..... \$42
It has deep, rich flavors of blueberry and ripe black currant, and a nice, velvety mouth feel. It finishes out with discreet notes of sweet oak and a touch of mint.
- Poggio Molina, Lo Scopaio, Tuscany, Italy** \$48
Elegant purple, with aromas of red currant which immediately give way to flowers, tobacco and cinnamon. It has the mineral pureness of Cabernet Franc, the fragrance of Merlot and the vivacity of Sangiovese.
- Marques de Riscal, Rioja Reserva, Spain**..... \$42
A dark cherry color with good depth. Balsamic aromas with hints of ripe fruit, complex and spicy. The attack is fresh and light, with soft, rounded tannins. The finish proves persistent with some reminders of toasted oak. Its passage through the mouth is pleasant and elegant, fresh and easy to drink.
- Villa Antinori, Tuscany, Italy**..... \$43
Intense ruby red color. Fruity hints on the nose blend well with the toasty, chocolate and vanilla notes from aging in wood. A complex, harmonious and well-structured wine with smooth tannins and persistent fruity hints.
- Cabernet Sauvignon, Faust, Rutherford, California**..... \$72
Flavors are of ripe, sweet fruit, with a hint of fresh rosemary chocolate, even fine tobacco on the finish.

- Fabiano, Amarone, Veneto, Italy** \$88
Smooth texture with ripe, flavorful berry fruit: blueberry, blackberry, raspberry, sour cherry. Ample acidity, medium tannins and hints of earth. This is a very pleasing, soft-style Amarone. It is big, bold and soft with a nice finish of fruit, acid and tannins in ample quantity with a hint of spice.
- Chianti Classico, Riserva Ducale “Gold” Ruffino, Italy**..... \$82
A luscious nose, hints of violets, berry fruit, chocolate and smoke. Excellent balance with remarkable depth.
- Magnificat, Franciscan “Oakville Estate”, California**..... \$96
Black cherry, plum, cedar and tobacco flavors. Firm on the finish, where the flavors build.
- Barolo, Pelassa, Piedmont, Italy** \$95
100% Nebbiolo. Brilliant garnet-red color. Deeply scented bouquet; it develops from the dried flowers and wild rose scent to “tar”, exalting the ethereal bouquet. Rich, ripe taste; tannic impressive and well-balanced. It is a powerful and rich wine.
- Barolo, Ca’ Bianca, Piedmont, Italy** \$90
100% Nebbiolo. Tightly knit, solid wine with chewy tannins and raisiny, stemmy character. Full-bodied, long and muscular.
- Brunello di Montalcino, Canalicchio, Italy**..... \$98
100% Sangiovese Grosso grapes, austere, mid-bodied, rich and fragrant.
- Barbaresco, Pio Cesare, Italy** \$115
100% Nebbiolo grapes. This Barbaresco has a glossy garnet color with light ruby shades. The bouquet is intense and fragrant with a hint of cinnamon and vanilla. This wine is quite full-bodied and powerful.
- Brunello, Fanti, Italy**..... \$135
The king of Italian wines. 100% Sangiovese Grosso, deep red color with a bouquet of wild fruits, very concentrated and spicy with accents of raspberries and an extremely smooth finish.
- Quintessa, Rutherford, California** \$195
A blend of the best vineyard lots of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot and Cabernet Franc. An outstanding mix of fruit with a lengthy finish.

- Tignanello, Tuscany, Italy** \$175
Intensely fruity and complex on the nose, full-bodied, rich and complex in the mouth, with exceptional structure and lengthy finish.
- Sassicaia, Tuscany, Italy** \$295
Excellent color, soft in the mouth with great personality with a very soft and harmonious tannic content. The tannins' sweetness produced a very elegant wine, supported by a remarkable body. Very fruity and complex, deep flavors that linger, smooth and soft finish.
- Tenuta dell' Ornellaia, Tuscany, Italy** \$295
A blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot and Cabernet Franc; elegant, fresh wine with outstanding notes of dark fruit and vanilla.
- Fumanelli, Amarone, Italy** \$92
Intense garnet red with a typical nose of dried grapes, full-bodied and warm on the palate, soft and perfectly balanced with hints of vanilla, mature fruit and sweet nutmeg.
- Opus One, Napa Valley, California** \$295
Aromas of blackberry, plum, hazelnut and olive oil, cocoa and dried cherries present a soft, rich entry. Nuances of dark chocolate and herbs linger on the finish.

- Dom Perignon, France** \$260
There's a high-toned, minty, graphite accent to the aroma, with a citric edge on the palate. The structure is overlaid with lemon and bread dough notes, tight and crisp on the finish.
- Perrier-Jouët "Fleur de Champagne", France** \$195
The wine shows hints of floral and fruit aromas, opening with white flowers and a touch of honey, ending with a hint of brioche. The palate is crisp and clean, with hints of almond and nougat. While the cuvée is light and elegant, it has a surprisingly long finish.
- Perrier-Jouët Fleur de Champagne Rosé, France** \$385
This Champagne possesses both remarkable delicacy and finesse, as well as certain full-bodied mellowness - all bound together in a magically radiant hue, perfect for your special loved one. A hint of soft tannin from the additional Pinot Noir makes Fleur de Champagne Rosé an ideal partner for fine cuisine.
